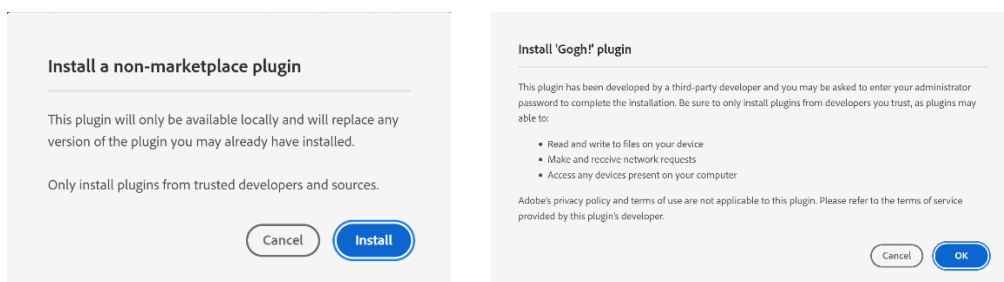

INSTALLING THE PLUGIN

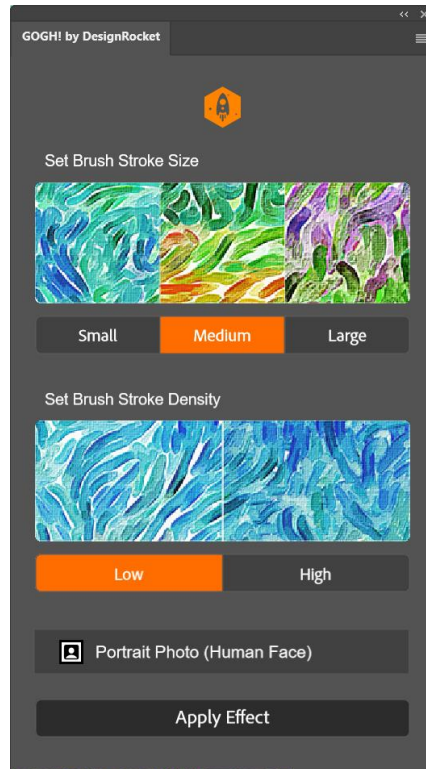
GOGH! comes as a Photoshop plugin (.ccx) file. You can open this file by double-clicking it in the Creative Cloud Desktop application. If you purchased the plugin from a source other than Adobe Exchange, you will encounter two warning messages. Please proceed by confirming these warning messages.

After installation, you can access the plugin through the Plugins menu in Photoshop



PLUGIN INTERFACE

GOGH! Has a quite simple user interface



SET BRUSH STROKE SIZE

This option allows you to choose from three different brush sizes. As the brush size increases, you will achieve more abstract results.

SET BRUSH STROKE DENSITY

option lets you determine the density of the brush strokes. This way, you can create your image with either more sparse or denser brush strokes.

PORTRAIT PHOTO

Portrait mode is an option that provides better results for portrait photos where a human face is the main subject. If you are not satisfied with the results in your portrait photos, you can enable this option.

IMAGE PREPERATION

With GOGH! the results you will obtain with different photos will vary, as not all photos used will possess the same technical qualities. GOGH! actually applies some basic preparatory stages before starting to work on the photos, but if you wish to alter the outcome, you can also make some basic adjustments to your photos before running GOGH! to differentiate your results.

These adjustments may include:

Shadows/Highlights

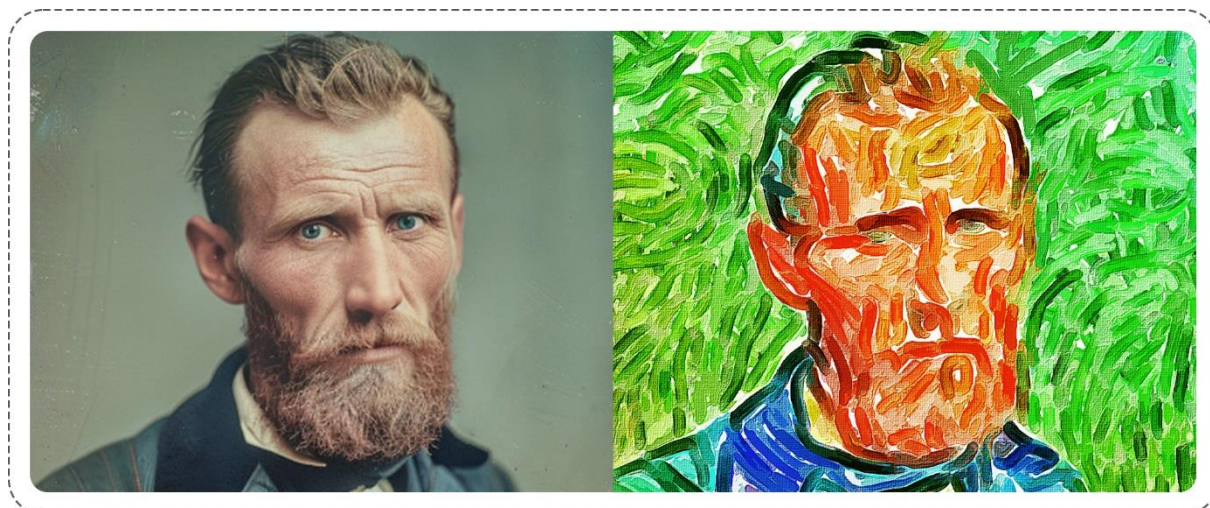
Smart Sharpen

Poster Edges

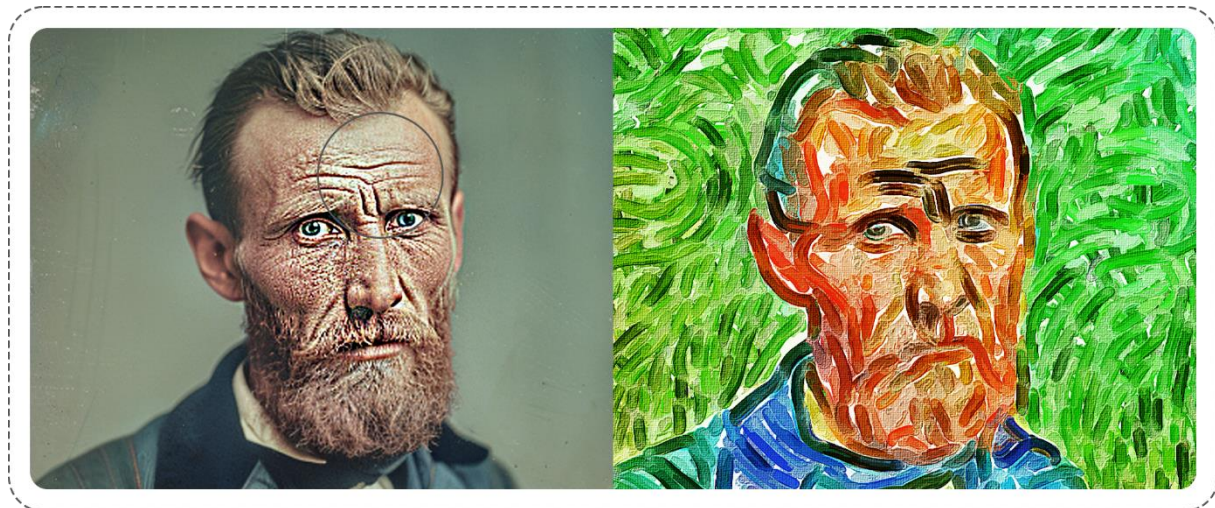
PORTRAIT PHOTOS

When you use Portrait mode in portrait photos, GOGH! will process these photos differently. However, even without using Portrait mode, you can perform some minor operations on your photo to achieve beautiful results. Here's one of them:

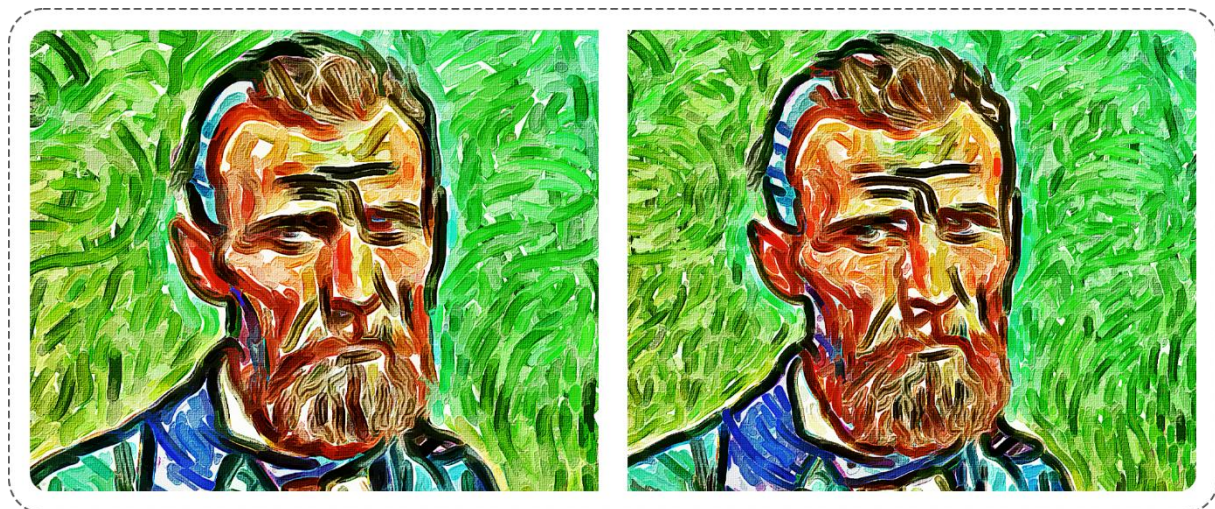
Open your photo, select the Sharpen Tool from the toolbox. Apply the Sharpen tool on the face in your photo to make the details of the face more pronounced, and then run GOGH! afterwards.
